*Account Set up to Enable Join Multiplayer Games, Join Clubs or Access Realms*

1. Log in to <https://account.xbox.com/settings> with the parent's Microsoft account.
2. Click the child account's profile.
3. In the navigation tabs click **Xbox One/Windows 10 Online**
4. Select **Allow** for **Join multiplayer games** and **You can create and join clubs**.

*To enable chat for people not on the child's friends list*

In the table header:

1. Click **Privacy**
2. Select **Others can communicate with voice, text, or invites**.

**Note:** This option determines who can see your child's messages and send your child's messages including in-game chat in Minecraft. These settings are specific to this account.

5. Click **Save**.

## Minor's GT

can:

See other people's Xbox Live profiles (Xbox 360: Profile Viewing)

Everybody Friends Block

Decide to allow or block seeing other people's game history and achievements from an Xbox One. A profile includes information about a member's game history and achievements. It can also contain a gamer's motto and personal info, which you may find inappropriate.

Use video for communications (Xbox 360: Video Communication)

Everybody Friends Block

Decide to allow or block communicating using video on Xbox Live. Video communication on Xbox One includes using Skype. On Xbox 360, this setting includes Video Kinect and in-game video.

Share stuff people make (Xbox 360: Member Content)

Everybody Friends Block

Decide who can see stuff you make, and whose stuff you can see. People can create images, text, and custom content in games and profiles, which you may find inappropriate. This setting doesn't affect seeing other people's game clips, content made with Upload Studio, content you view in Remix 3D, content already downloaded, nor download of Indie Games.

This determines who can see your messages & send you messages, including in-game chat in Minecraft

Others can:

See your Xbox profile (Xbox 360: Profile Sharing)

Everybody Friends Block

Decide who can see info you choose to add to your Xbox profile.

Others can communicate with voice, text, or invites

Everybody Friends Block

Decide who to communicate with on Xbox Live using voice and text and also who sends you invitations to parties or clubs. This setting is about who you want to communicate
